HOW TO....

....WORK THE TELEPHONE

To call across to The Olive Branch dial '#1' or '#2'.

If you wish to make an external call then please press '9' followed by the desired number in full (e.g. 9 01780410355). Our charges are 25p for the first minute and 18p thereafter.

You can use the phone to call through to another room by simply dialling '20' followed by the room number;

Biscuit = 1 Aubergine = 4
Berry = 2 Double Cream = 5
Apple = 3 Chocolate = 6

The telephone can also be used as an alarm clock, pick up the handset and dial 18 followed by your desired time in 24hour format, so to set an alarm for 7.05 am dial 18 0705 and wait for the confirmation tone. By 'answering' the phone the following morning this cancels the alarm, if you ignore it; it will call you back 5 minutes later.



....USE THE TELEVISION

The television in your room is simply operated using the remote control situated by the television. To switch on, simply press the desired number to tune to this channel. Standard freeview television channels are available.

Netflix is available through the smart button on the remote.

Please let us know if you require a DVD player and we can come over and install one for you.

....USE THE RADIO

To use your radio, first pull up the aerial up so that it is fully extended and press the volume button to turn it on. The tuning button is located on the right hand side which alters the station. Press this button down to get the station you prefer. There is another button which changes it from DAB to FM.

The local Radio station is Rutland Radio 107.2.



....ACCESS TO THE INTERNET

Wi-fi is offered throughout Beech House for all guests to use complimentary.

....USE THE COFFEE MACHINE

- 1. Fill up with water.
- 2. Switch the machine on by pressing either of the two buttons on the top machine.
- 3. Lift the lever and insert the capsule, foil top forward.
- 4. Close the lever and place a cup under the spout.
- 5. Press the appropriate button for the coffee size you would like.
- 6. When machine has stopped, remove cup, enjoy coffee, lift and close the lever to eject the capsule.
- 7. Leave the used capsules in the container in the machine.



ALTERNATIVE BEDDING

If you find the duvet cover in your room is too warm to sleep under then we have put an extra sheet which can be found in the wardrobe or chest of drawers and you are more than welcome to use this, if you would like us to prepare the bed with this sheet and a blanket then please call across to The Olive Branch and we can change it for you.

IRONING BOARD

PLACES OF INTEREST

CLIPSHAM YEW TREES the Yew Tree Avenue is a unique collection of 150 clipped yew trees, most over 200 years old. The Avenue was once the carriage drive to Clipsham Hall, the centre of the Clipsham Estate. It is just a five minute drive or a 15-20 minute walk from Beech House, out of the front gate turn right and carry on through the village up the (small) hill and the avenue is on the left and side.



OAKHAM is Rutland's County Town, a peaceful country town with a good selection of shops from antique furnishing to designer clothes shops. Oakham becomes a bustling market place on Wednesday and Saturday with a farmers market on the last Saturday of each month.

STAMFORD is situated just south of Clipsham about 10 minutes down the A1. Stamford is a picturesque town that has been used for filming the BBC Middlemarch series and more recently the Hollywood blockbuster "Pride and Prejudice." Visit on a Friday for market day.



BARNSDALE GARDENS at Barnsdale in Rutland were built by Britain's best loved television gardener, Geoff Hamilton, over several years for BBC TV Gardeners' World.

Located 7 miles from Beech House. Turn Left out of Beech House through Stretton, over the first roundabout and at the second roundabout take the first exit to Greetham, after Greetham take the first left signposted Exton and then follow signposts to Barnsdale, about 10-15 minutes drive from Beech House.

EASTON WALLED GARDENS have been renovated over the last few years. These once lost Gardens have been transformed with drifts of bulbs, meadow borders, auricular theatres & a turf maze. Situated 11 miles from Beech House, travel northbound on the A1, after 8 miles take the next junction (the B6403), then first left signposted 'EASTON.'



BURGHLEY HOUSE is situated just outside of Stamford, one of the largest Elizabethan Houses in England, and is also home to the renowned Burghley Horse trials. It is open to the public from mid-March to November (House is closed on a Friday), with over 80 rooms to explore and acres of parkland and extensive classic gardens, as well as a lovely sculpture garden, beautiful for peaceful walks.

RUTLAND WATER is the largest man made reservoir in Europe and has over 18 miles of dedicated cycle paths to explore. There is also a nature reserve, butterfly farm and ferry boats are available to travel out onto the reservoir.
